In exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 32 of the Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations 2010 and in supersession of the earlier notifications or orders issued in this behalf, the Government of Karnataka hereby directs; that all generating units in the State of Karnataka of capacity exceeding 10 KW shall be inspected by the Electrical Inspector before commissioning.

Provided that, the installations belonging to Government of India or its undertaking are excluded from inspection by the Electrical Inspector of the State.

**No. EN 245 EBS 2014, Bengaluru, Dated: 19.01.2015**

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub regulation (1) & (2) of regulation 30 of the Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations 2010 and in supersession of the earlier notifications/orders issued in this behalf, the Government of Karnataka hereby directs; that where an installation in the State of Karnataka is already connected to the supply system of the supplier or trader, every such class of installation specified in column(2) of the Table below shall be periodically inspected and tested by the authority specified in column (4) at such intervals specified in column (3) thereof either by Electrical Inspector or by supplier as the case may be.

Provided that, the installations belonging to Government of India or its undertaking are excluded from inspection by the Electrical Inspector of the State.

**No. EN 245 EBS 2014, Bengaluru, Dated: 19.01.2015**

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-regulation (1) of regulation 36 of the Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations 2010 and in supersession of the earlier notifications/orders issued in this behalf, the Government of Karnataka hereby directs; that all Multi-storied buildings in the State of Karnataka of more than fifteen meters height (as defined in National Building Code) with connected load of exceeding 250 Watts and One hundred volts shall be inspected by the Electrical Inspector.

Provided that, the installations belonging to Government of India or its undertaking are excluded from inspection by the Electrical Inspector of the State.

**No. EN 245 EBS 2014, Bengaluru, Dated: 19.01.2015**

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-regulation (1) of regulation 43 of the Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations 2010 and in supersession of the earlier notifications/orders issued in this behalf, the Government of Karnataka, hereby directs; that all electrical installations and apparatus of voltage exceeding 650 volts in the State of Karnataka shall be inspected by the Electrical Inspector before commencement of supply or recommencement after shutdown for six months.

Provided that, the installations belonging to Government of India or its undertaking are excluded from inspection by the Electrical Inspector of the State.
